

BARRIE SENIOR COED SLO-PITCH LEAGUE

CONSTITUTION

BSCSL is a recreational coed Slo-pitch league for players 55 and older.

LEAGUE EXECUTIVE

1. The League Executive will consist of the following positions:

President
Vice President
Treasurer
Secretary
Past President

2. The five-person League Executive is empowered to direct, manage, supervise and control all operations and finances of the BSCSL and as such are responsible for the proper running and maintenance of the league. Board Members will be elected at the AGM for a term of 2 years. Elected board members will decide which positions they fill. Board can delegate responsibility to volunteers for various activities.

TEAM MANAGERS

1. Team Managers (TM) will be a voluntary position.
2. TM can recommend a player from their team to the position of Assistant Manager. League Executive will approve all Assistant Managers.
3. TM will communicate league documents to players. Support the League's Code of Conduct and Rules to their team members.
4. TM will be responsible for the on-field management and actions of their team and their spectators, and report any instances of objectionable conduct to the League Executive.
5. TM will complete forms to report any injury or incident immediately and provide to an executive member.
6. If required, TM will temporarily suspend any player who violates the Code of Conduct for the remainder of a play date and report incident to the League Executive.
7. TM will assume control and responsibility for the League equipment and uniforms assigned to their team and return when requested.
8. TM will attend meetings of League Executive as requested.
9. TM will complete player ratings forms at the end of the season to assist in the following year's draft.

10. As a group, the Team Managers will participate in drafting teams for the upcoming year.

Sportsmanship:

1. While it is understandable that in the heat of competition, players may occasionally have heightened emotions, the BSCSL is a recreational league and all players are expected to behave in a cordial and respectful manner.
2. As such, only Team Manager or the Assistant Manager respectfully discuss questionable calls or rule interpretations with the Umpire.

Discipline Committee:

1. The discipline committee will be made up of the Executive members.
2. Decisions by Discipline committee will be final.

PLAYERS

1. Players must be 55 years of age within the calendar year.
2. Players shall report any injuries or illnesses that will affect the player's ability to play, to the Team Manager. Players need to advise of any vacation or games that they are unable to play in advance.
3. Agree to abide by the Code of Conduct, and Rules of the League, and any decisions of the Disciplinary Committee.
4. No alcoholic beverages are permitted by players or fans whether on the playing field, stands or parking lots at the diamonds.

FINANCIAL POLICY

1. An annual operating budget shall be established prior to the beginning of each slo-pitch season in order to forecast anticipated expenses and to determine projected revenues.
2. The League Executive will develop an annual operating budget (including the recommended player registration fees) and maintain a set of records of all transactions that could be audited if required
3. The League account may be accessed, and disbursements made, solely via cheque with receipts and explanations.
4. Any cheque issued requires the signatures of two members of the League Executive.

5. As a non-profit organization, surplus operating funds from one fiscal year will be rolled over to the following fiscal year.

SPONSORSHIP

1. To defray operating expenses of the League, the League may seek financial support from businesses, organizations, or individuals for a fee and length of time as determined by the League Executive.
2. Sponsorship may be a) a single sponsor for the entire league; b) multiple sponsors for the League; or c) sponsors for individual teams.
3. Payment of sponsorship fees from any business, organization, or individual will entitle same to have their name appear on the uniforms or other league materials.
4. The League Executive and Team Managers will do their best to endorse and promote player support for League sponsor(s).

TEAM DRAFT

1. The Executive Committee will coordinate the rating of all players according to offense and defense.
2. The Team Managers collectively will participate in the draft as per the ratings with due diligence as to making the teams as balanced as possible.

EVENTS

1. League executive may decide to hold events throughout the season or as a wrap-up.
