Player Code of Conduct

To ensure we meet our goal of providing an enjoyable and social atmosphere where competitive games may be played in the spirit of good sportsmanship, our players are expected to comply with the following standards of behavior:

All players shall:

1. Respect the game, play fairly and follow its rules and regulations.
2. Accept judgment decisions made by umpires and Managers during the game.
3. Refrain from using any intoxicating substances during the course of the game, nor appear to be in an intoxicated condition.
4. Demonstrate good sportsmanship and ethical behavior before, during and after games. This includes refraining from any behaviour that could be considered to be harassment, discrimination or abuse of any kind.
5. Respect the privilege and rules of using public facilities.

It is incumbent upon Team Managers and League Executive to oversee the league, safeguard these principles and take appropriate and corrective action when they become aware of instances such as:

- Abuse (including verbal, physical and emotional)
- Disparaging remarks,
- Intimidating, unethical or threatening behavior,
- Violent reaction towards an official, opponent, player or spectator.

If a coach or volunteer receives a complaint about any incident that cannot be resolved immediately, they must immediately report the incident to a member of the Executive in writing. The Executive will follow up on the complaint through the Discipline process.
